

Assembly documentation Contec.safe Info letter

Dear customers

The European standard DIN EN 795:2012 as well as the regulations of the Municipal Accident Insurance Association require mandatory documentation of the installation of anchor devices for rope anchorage protection, which must be prepared by the installation company.

This therefore also applies to Contec.safe fall protection products. These products must be inspected at least every 12 months. Proper installation documentation must be available for these inspections.

To make it easier for you to prepare this documentation, you will therefore receive the installation documentation form together with the documents enclosed with the delivery, with instructions on how to complete it and also with suggestions on how to set up the photo gallery.

The installation documentation must contain, among other things, a whole range of data about the object, the installation company, the responsible installer and the product used. In addition, the installation documentation also serves as proof that the installation has been carried out properly.

In addition to filling out the form, the arrangement of the various anchor points and the course of the rope must also be drawn in on a site plan, and photographic documentation of the various assembly steps must be prepared. This is particularly important if relevant components of the anchor device are no longer visible after completion of the work, such as the safety fleece in the case of the various Contec products.

The copy that comes to the construction site with the delivery papers is, by the way, intended to help you record the relevant entries already during installation, together with the creation of the picture gallery. The copy, which is sent digitally by e-mail to your office, can then be used to transfer these entries into the clean and then handed over to your customer together with the attached picture gallery. If you wish, we can also provide you with the documentation digitally, please contact us for this.

One of the reasons why the installation documentation is so important is that the person who installs the Contec. safe equipment is not always the person who later maintains or inspects the equipment. Independent inspectors are therefore dependent on neat, clean and complete documentation in order to be able to evaluate the functional condition of the anchor devices with a reasonable amount of effort.

In any case, keep a copy of the entire installation documentation with your own records in order to be able to prove proper installation on your part in case of inquiries by third parties, loss of the papers by the builder or also possibly because of given burden of proof.
